

Are you Loss Adjuster of the Year?

- Services to the Community Award
- Innovation of the Year

The Awards, hosted by the Institute in conjunction with *Asia Insurance Review*, will be presented at a gala presentation evening on Thursday 7 August at the Parkside Ballroom, Sydney Convention and Exhibition Centre.
